- Be accepted or anticipate being accepted to:
  - A two-year community college,
  - o A state owned or state related four-year college or university,
  - A specialized training institution or trade school
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or someone of importance to you
- Submit transcripts with completed application

## Instructions

- A \$500 renewable scholarship will be awarded for the first and second years of postsecondary education.
- Complete an application, including a letter of recommendation and transcripts, and submit to the Bethel Park Guidance Office by April 1. Second year renewable application consists of copy of original application along with current post-secondary transcripts with QPA of at least 2.50. Submit all to: BETHEL PARK COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, PO Box 811, Bethel Park, PA 15102.
- All information provided on the application form must be typed or printed in black or blue ink and must be clear and legible.
- The Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of the scholarship.
